## How to get there:

### From the airport

Take the Metro (not the regional or regular trains!) towards “Vanløse”. Get off at “Kongens Nytorv. Walk as shown on the map below (the blue line from the green “pillar”, to the red “pillar”. If you’re walking you don’t need to go via Sankt Annae Plads but can walk directly from the end of Nyhavn (the blue canal) into Store Strandstræde 18.

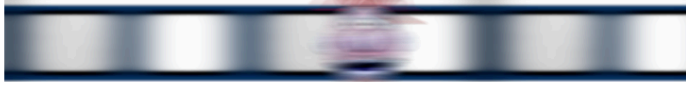
Anyone arriving to Copenhagen from outside Denmark (by plane or train) should get off and continue their travels via the Metro from there. Taxi will not save you any time either...(the Metro takes approximately 15-20 minutes).

### From the main train station

If you arrive to the central train station/Hovedbanegården (which you should only have to do if your’re travelling within Denmark, you can find your way by visiting [www.krak.dk](http://www.krak.dk) and choosing your present location and giving your destination under “ruteplan” or by pointing out your destination under “Kort”. Bus 1A at Hovedbanegården (from the viaduct crossing the tracks) will also take you to Kongens Nytorv, from where you can walk with ease.
